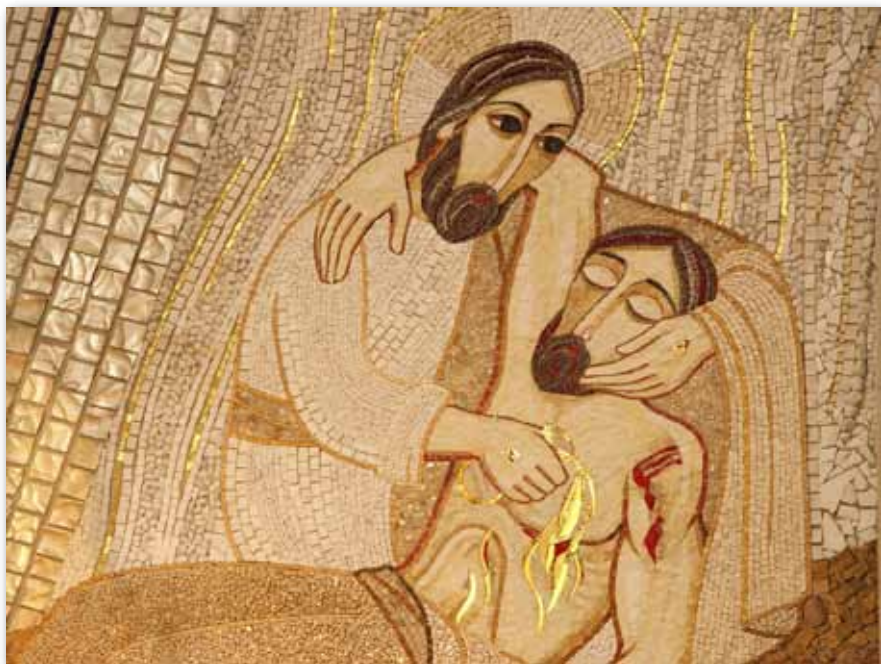

ST ANDREW'S PARISH CHURCH
